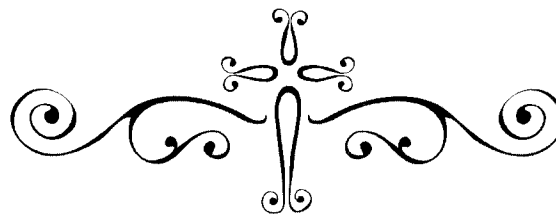

Most recently, the ensembles sang at the annual FLC Patron's Luncheon, and participated in the Invitational Choral Festival, **SacSings** at Sacramento City College, where they were one of the only non-auditioned ensembles invited to participate.

**The FLC Youth Chamber** Orchestra is one of the most captivating young artists' ensembles of the Greater Sacramento area. Established only five years ago as a "pilot project" at the Folsom Lake College, the group has quickly gained recognition for its expressive and imaginative performances at the Harris Center for the Arts (former Three Stages). From their choice of challenging repertoire, which spans across from

Baroque to Contemporary and from Classical to Jazz, to their unique "rotation" system, that requires violinists to switch from first to second violin sections in one performance, to their attention to details in articulation and dynamics - FLC Youth Chamber Orchestra surprises and excites the audience. Despite the fact, that some of these young artists are still in the middle school, every semester they earn college credit (advanced education) as the Folsom Lake College students. **Dr. Evgeniy Sporov** , was born in Gorky (also known as Nizhny Novgorod), Russia, Dr. Evgeniy Sporov began his violin and piano studies at the age of six and has since performed as a soloist, chamber and orchestral musician throughout Russia, Germany, Greece and the United States. Dr. Sporov's first public appearance as a violinist took place in the Great Hall of Glinka State Conservatory in Nizhny Novgorod when he was nine. Dr. Sporov is an accomplished music educator. Between 1997 and 1999, while still living in Russia, he served as the regional supervisor of the string departments of 127 music schools and four music colleges in the state of Nizhny Novgorod. After moving to the United States, he taught at the Interlochen and Blue Lake Fine Arts Camps, and worked for the Jackson Symphony Orchestra Association (Jackson, MI) as a violin instructor. Dr. Sporov holds a Bachelor of Music degree in Violin Performance and a Master of Music degree in Chamber Music from the Glinka State Conservatory. In 2006, he earned his Doctoral of Music Arts degree in Violin Performance from Michigan State University.

In 2012, he was appointed to become the artistic director and conductor of the newly formed FLC Youth Chamber Orchestra, and in the fall of 2015, Dr. Sporov accepted the position of adjunct professor of violin at the William Jessup University. Dr. Sporov has frequently appeared as either a concertmaster or assistant/associate concertmaster with many symphony orchestras.
