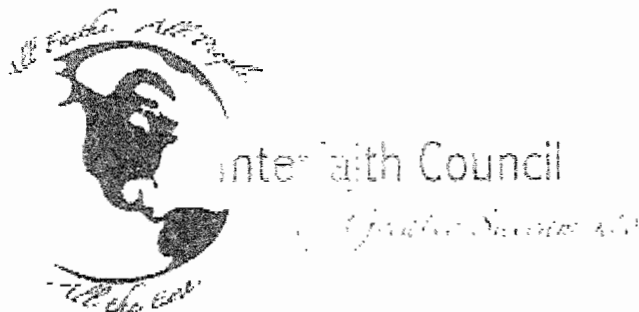
## Mission Statement
