CRC CHAMBER SINGERS program notes:

Trond Kverno, Norwegian composer, has set this Marian antiphon for six-part choir. You'll hear the featuring of women, men, rich antiphonal singing, and the soothing of chant all woven into one piece. This ninth-century hymn is a common work venerating Mary – we hope you enjoy Kverno's setting of that text.

A Quiet Place

Jerry Rubino arranged this piece for the well known male sextet Take Six. The tough harmonies are not for the timid!

Text:

There is a quiet place, Far from the rapid pace Where God can soothe my troubled mind, Sheltered by tree and flow'r, There in my quiet hour, With Him my cares are left behind, Whether a garden small, Or on a mountain tall, New strength and courage there I find, Then from this quiet place, I go prepared to face, A new day with love for all mankind.

Cúnnla

This is a short, fast piece in the Irish Gaelic language for female voices in an original setting by the director of the Celtic group Anuna.

Loch Lomond

This song is most likely a tale about two of Bonnie Prince Charlie's men, captured and left behind in Carlisle after the failed rising in 1745. One is to be executed, while the other is set free. According to Celtic tradition, the condemned man's spirit would return to his homeland via the "low road": His spirit will reach Scotland before his comrade gets home, but he will never meet his true love again.
